The Longbush Playgroup Midwinter Ceilidh was a huge success and a lot of fun was had by all. There were some great outfits and highland flinging to match!

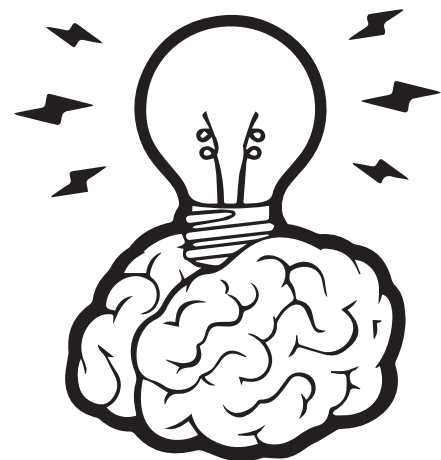
